

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Open:	Rs. 1,99,000/-	Rs.202,000/-															
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11.	EXAMINATION AND METHOD OF ASSESSMENT	:	103 Credits in 4 semesters. Out of which credits will have a component of internal as well as external evaluation & 13 credits will be exclusively internal evaluation including Integrated Disaster Management. Each credit is defined as 15 hours of teaching. Each														

			credit is assessed for 50 Marks. Internal assessment will be of 60% and external will be of 40% for all external courses. Internal programmes will be evaluated 100% internally by the institute.
12.	STANDARD OF PASSING	:	<p>A student has to pass both internal &amp; external exam separately. The assessment of the student for each course is done based on the relative performance of the student compared to the class average. Maximum GP is 4 corresponding to A+ grade.</p> <p>The grade F (GP less than 1.6) of Individual head (internal &amp; external) will be considered as fail.</p> <p>The degree will be awarded after taking into consideration the performance of the student in all 4 semesters.</p> <p>A student will be eligible for award of the degree only if he obtains a minimum of 2.00 CGPA at the end of 4 semesters.</p>
13.	AWARD OF DEGREE	:	Master of Business Administration (Hospital and Healthcare Management) will be the degree awarded.
